#### Year One also studied Jackson Pollock and made their own paint splatter artworks!








#### Year Two visited St. Stephen's church to gain inspiration whilst designing their stained glass windows.

#### Year Six virited The Tate Modern and took part in a workshop with an artist.






#### Year Six began designing murals that they have now painted onto the fencing around the top playground.
