- 4. Various answers. Brother =  $25 (5^2)$ ; Mother =  $64 (4^3)$ ; Daughter  $1 = 8 (2^3)$  and Daughter  $2 = 16 (4^2)$ . 8 is half of 16.
- 5. Paulo has multiplied 6 by 2 instead of calculating  $6^2$  which equals 36. He needs 36 planks which is also the biggest raft he can make as 7 x 7 = 49 and he only has 40 planks.
- 6. Paulo has 1,200 miles to reach home. He calculated 12 x 100 incorrectly as 12,000 to begin with. This then made his division incorrect.  $1,200 \div 100 = 12$ cm so he has 1,200 miles to reach home.
