Athelstan was King of the Anglo-Saxons from 924 to 927 and King of the English from 927 to 939. [a] He was the son of King Edward the Elder and his first wife, Ecgwynn. Historians regard him as the first King of England and one of the greatest Anglo-Saxon kings. He never married, and was succeeded by his half-brother, Edmund.


