COVID-19

Please remember that if your child or anyone in your household develops one or more of the three main symptoms of coronavirus, they must not attend school, you must book a PCR test at a testing site (not conduct a lateral flow test) and the whole household must isolate until the results are received and shared with the school:

- A new cough – this can be any type of cough
- A temperature that is 37.7 or above
- A loss or change to their sense of taste or smell

Please remember that the above procedure applies if just one of the above symptoms are present, and this is a key control to protect our school community.

Home-Start is here to offer compassionate, confidential support to families where:

- Children have disabilities or developmental delays.
- Parents are experiencing emotional health difficulties like post-natal depression or anxiety.
- Life feels unstable because of financial worries, relationship issues or living in poor housing.
- Parents are finding the early years of their children's lives demanding and would like help.

As a local volunteer-focused charity, we really understand families and our local communities.

We support families who:

- Have at least one child under the age of five, including mums-to-be in the third trimester of pregnancy
- Live in the borough of Richmond, Kingston or Hounslow.

All our volunteers are parents themselves or have parenting experience. We carefully match one volunteer to each family and they offer support once a week, via phone and video calls. They are there to talk through the worries and joys of family life, share ideas and signpost other useful resources.

While we are currently restricted from visiting family homes, we are delivering activity bags for children to doorsteps and can help with story time over video calls.
